Senator John F Kerry and four Olympic athletes Sign Book to go on Auction Block at WGBH-TV, Channel 2, Boston, MA

LENOX, Mass. - May 24, 2007 (SEND2PRESS NEWSWIRE) -- Boston's annual WGBH-TV auction, the largest community-driven event in New England, has a book with notable signatures on the auction block this year signed by Senator Kerry, Billy Rodgers, Frank Shorter, Joan Benoit and Catherine Ndereba, notes author Kathleen Cleary.
